ONE OF WAHKIAKUM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows: 8 WHEREAS, Public Utility District No. One of Wahkiakum County, Washington ("District") is 9 a municipal corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the Constitution and the laws of the State of Washington; and, 10 WHEREAS, the District anticipates the potential future acquisition of one or more sanitary sewer 11 systems within Wahkiakum County, and seeks to ensure it has the legal authority to operate such systems should such an acquisition occur; and 12 WHEREAS, RCW 54.16.230 requires voter approval at a general election before a public utility 13 district may operate a sanitary sewer system; and 14 WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the District finds it in the public interest to submit the matter to the voters by referendum at a general election; 15 16 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED: 17 1. Authorization of Referendum. A referendum proposition shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the District at the next general election conducted by Wahkiakum 18 County, currently scheduled for November 4, 2025, or such later general election date as determined in coordination with the County Auditor.
