ONE OF WAHKIAKUM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows: 7 WHEREAS, Public Utility District No. One of Wahkiakum County, Washington ("District") is 8 a municipal corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the Constitution and the 9 laws of the State of Washington; and, 10 WHEREAS, the District and the Town of Cathlamet (the "Town") entered into an Operating Agreement on June 2, 2025, under which the District has assumed operational responsibility for 11 the Town's water and wastewater utility systems; and 12 WHEREAS, the Operating Agreement provides that the District will administer billing of Town rates and charges for Town System service to the Town, its residents and other users of the Town 13 System until such time as the PUD adopts a schedule of rates and charges for Town System customers by resolution; and 14 WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds it in the best interest of the District and its 15 ratepayers to formally adopt the Town's current in-town water and existing sewer rates for continued use during the period of District operation. 16 17 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED: 18 1. Adoption of Rates. The District hereby adopts the current Town of Cathlamet in-town water and existing sewer rate schedules, including all base rates, usage charges, and fees, as the official 19 rates to be charged to all customers of the Town's water and sewer systems operated by the District. 12	**Sewer Volume Charge shall be calculated by multiplying the sewer volume charge by the winter-average*** calculated based on the measured volume of water from all sources consumed on the premises. It is the intent of this section to calculate sewer volume charges based on water that should enter the sewerage system, and not on water used exclusively for irrigation or sprinkling.

15	***Sewer winter-averages for the following user classes shall be calculated in the following manner: > Standard: based on the average of metered water consumption, excluding the first 600		
16	cf, during a consecutive three-month period, after December 1st and before March 1st. > Special: The following accounts and/or user classifications shall have a winter-usage		
17	established as follows: (a) "Multiple-family (multifamily) dwelling": based on the average of metered water consumption, excluding the first 600 cf per each residential unit, during a consecutive three-month period after December 1st and before March 1st. (e.g. an account with 3 residential units shall have the first 1,800 cf excluded.) (b) "Multiple-residential/commercial unit": based on the average of metered water consumption, excluding the first 600 cf per each

20	residential unit, during a consecutive three-month period after December 1st and before Marc (e.g. an account with 2 commercial units and 3 residential units shall have the first 1,80		
21	excluded.)		
22	2. Effective Date. These adopted rates shall be effective as of the August 2025 billing cycle, and shall remain in effect until such time as the Board of Commissioners takes further action to		
23	revise or adopt new rate schedules.
