Attention Wahkiakum PUD Residential Electric Customers:

Wahkiakum PUD is participating in the Clean Energy Credits for Washington Families Program. Wahkiakum PUD residential customers may receive a text, email or direct mailing from Promise encouraging you to apply for a bill credit of \$200. The Washington State Department of Commerce and Promise are partnering with local utilities to distribute funds to help low- or moderate-income households pay their electricity bills. The Clean Energy Credits for Washington Families Program will offer bill credits of \$200 per household to eligible residential customers by September 15, 2024.

What is Promise? Promise is a software company specializing in relief distribution and revenue recovery for government. Promise works with state and local governments to distribute funds to utility customers for aid on their utility bills.

Who is Eligible? Low- and moderate-income electric utility customers in the state of Washington

FAQ:

- Funding is limited and available until funds are exhausted. The program ends September 15, 2024.
- You must be an electric residential customer of Wahkiakum PUD.
- This program is intended for low to moderate income households.
- Customers must apply to be eligible for the bill credit. Applying is free. There are no fees to apply, and no credit card or banking information is requested.
- To apply you will need your Wahkiakum PUD account number, the number of people who live with you, and your household pre-tax income from 2023.
- If approved, Wahkiakum PUD will receive notification that your account has been approved. If your application is approved and when funds are released to Wahkiakum PUD, a bill credit will be applied to your Wahkiakum PUD electric account.
